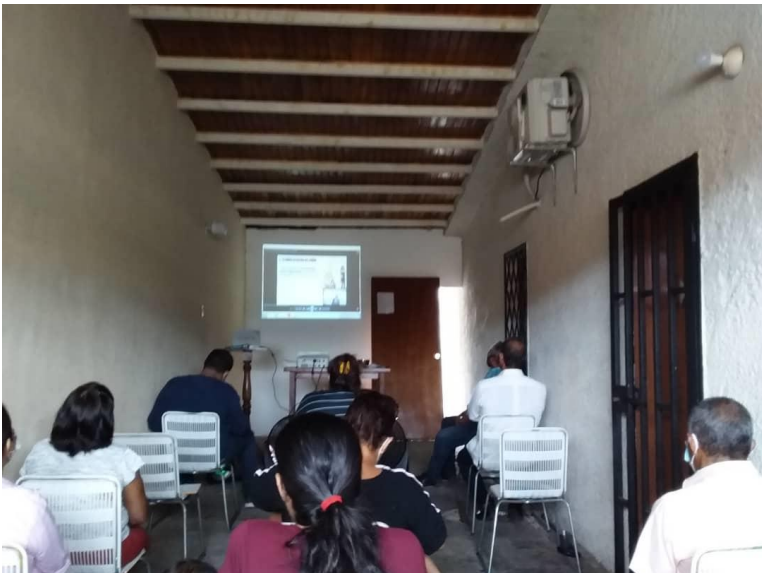
Without further ado and hoping that the work being done here in Barinas is to your liking.
